Top of 1st inning (Cotulla on offense), 2 out with runner R1 (#7, Joseph Garcia, F2) on 2nd base

### **Narrative**

#### 1. Player Ejection - Malicious Contact

Top of 1st inning (Cotulla on offense), 2 out with runner R1 (#7, Joseph Garcia, F2) on 2nd base.

Batter singles to the outfield and R1 attempts to score.

Throw is on line from F8 (center fielder) and is cleanly caught by F2 (JC Garcia, #13) just in front of home plate and 4 steps ahead of R1 running from 3rd.

F2 then steps into the base path to tag R1.

R1 lowers his shoulders and without deviating at all to go around F2, or without making any other attempt to avoid contact, runs into F2 at full speed with his shoulder and head to F2's chest and head area, knocking him backward.

In my opinion, the actions of R1 (J. Garcia, #7) constituted malicious contact. He was called out for the 3rd out of the inning and immediately ejected.

Mr. John Libby, Cotulla head coach, came out to question and discuss the call and accepted the explanation/reasoning for the MC ejection of #7.

J. Garcia, #7 was substituted with #25, Gerado Nieto.
